## LDP Delivery Agreement consultation

### Delivery Agreement consultees ('specific' consultation bodies)

Certain specified organisations and groups must be consulted on the draft Delivery Agreement (which includes the Community Involvement Scheme) before it is agreed with WAG. These are known as 'specific' consultation bodies.

These are:

- The Countryside Council for Wales
- The Environment Agency
- Cadw
- The National Assembly
- Planning Authorities in the vicinity (e.g. in the case of Gwynedd, Snowdonia National Park Authority, Conwy, Ceredigion, Anglesey and Powys County Councils)
- All Town and Community Councils falling completely or partly within the development plan area
- Operators of electronic communications apparatus
- Local Health Boards
- Electricity undertakers (Scottish Power, Powersystems and National Grid)
- Gas undertakers (Transco)
- Sewerage undertakers (Dŵr Cymru / Welsh Water and United Utilities)
- Water undertakers (Welsh Water, Severn Trent Water, Babcie)
- The Planning Inspectorate

### Community Involvement Scheme consultees ('general' consultation bodies)

Other organisations and groups must be consulted on that part of the Delivery Agreement which sets out anticipated consultation arrangements, which is the Community Involvement Scheme. These are known as 'general' consultation bodies.

General consultation bodies are not specified in the regulations and the local planning authority needs to define the appropriate representative bodies for its area according to the following headings:

- voluntary bodies whose activities benefit any part of the development plan area.
- bodies representing the interests of different racial, ethnic or national groups in the area.
- bodies representing the interests of different religious groups in the area.
- bodies representing the interests of disabled people in the area.
- bodies representing the interests of elderly people.
- bodies representing the interests of people carrying on business in the area.
- bodies representing the interests of Welsh culture in the area.
- bodies representing the interests of voluntary groups in the area.
- local Members of Parliament and Welsh Assembly Constituency Members.
